The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is an unit responsible for ensuring and maintaining the quality of internal processes and procedures inside an organization.

One of the most crucial components of IQAC is responsible for maintaining and improving the quality of education and general operation of an institution.

- It oversees and assesses the college's performance based on predetermined criteria and benchmarks.
- The IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) ensures that the college strictly follows the policies and guidelines established by the Governing Council and other regulatory bodies under SRA (Statutory Regulatory Authority).
- The IQAC of the college is highly active and actively involves all stakeholders, particularly trustees and students, to enhance the quality of the education system for teachers.

The Cell coordinates a range of academic and extracurricular activities, including webinars, seminars, art and craft projects, home assignments, essay tests, class tests, content tests, practice teaching, community work, internships, ICT (Information and Communication Technology), Nai Taleem, Constructivism lessons, micro teaching skill curriculum activities, and guest lectures.

The library is equipped with an Integrated Library Management System, ILMS: 'e - Granthalaya', which facilitates the maintenance of records for books and journals. The reading room has a capability to accommodate a maximum of 100 pupils and 20 teachers simultaneously. The library offers e-learning resources.
