## Microteaching - Meaning / Definition

Micro teaching is a procedure in which a student teacher practices teaching with a reduce number of pupils in a reduced period of time with emphasis on a narrow and specific teaching skill



### What is Microteaching?

- •Teaching of a small unit of content to the small group of students (6-10 number) in a small amount of time (5-10 min.)
- •To train inexperience student-teachers for acquiring teaching skills.
- •To improve the skills of experience teachers.




