

- Language is a very important means of communication between humans.






Definition of Language




Gleason says:

All are valid and useful as well as interesting."








Intellectual Development

- Believes that language is the vocalization of thoughts.
- According to them ,both language and thought are the same.
- Language helps students to verbalize his thoughts.
- Sensory motor and pre operational thoughts to more abstract levels of thoughts.

- Psychologist like Piaget belongs to this school
- Believes that thoughts and Language are two separate aspects and thought precedes language.
- Language only builds on thoughts as can be seen by study of deaf children.
