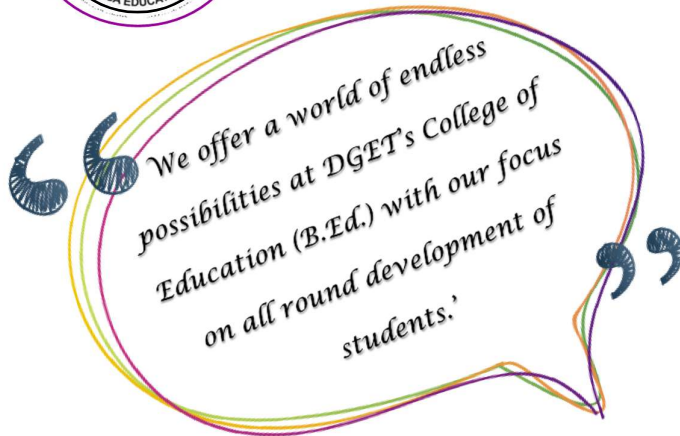

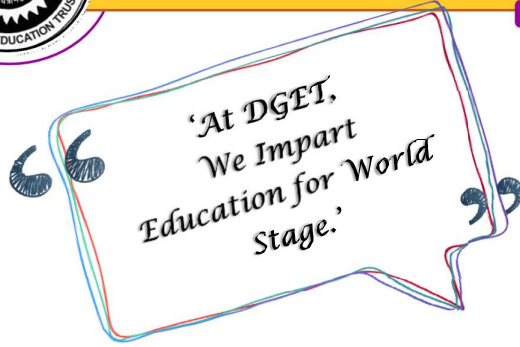

surrounding areas, demonstrating her strong commitment to environmental sustainability.

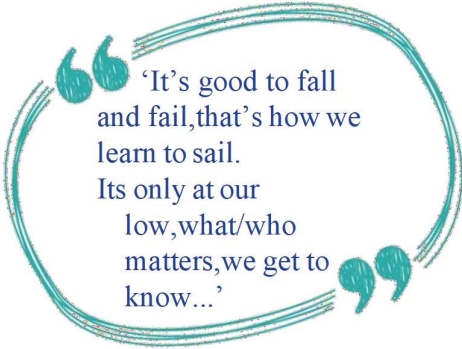
